Hello everyone,

I hope you are all well. The Legion has put a team together to study the feasibility of implementing a credit card system for the Canteen and Kitchen. The team is headed by Ted Clark, and he would like your input regarding such a system at Post 90. Ted Clark will be sending a separate email to you regarding the credit card system.

The first two months of 2022 have been very busy at Post 90, and the Bartending and Kitchen Crews have prepared many cold beverages and many fine meals for Post 90 events and on a daily basis. Our blood drive in January raised 18 units for Lee Health, and we are scheduling our next blood drive in May 2022; remember, you will get a burger, chips and a soda if you try. On February 6th, we had a successful Four Chaplains Ceremony, and on February 13, the Post hosted a Super Bowl Party that was well attended. Our participation in manning the First Base Grill at Jet Blue Park for the Boston Red Sox training camp is underway. We still have games in March, and would like help from our members so that we can raise money again this year to donate to needy charities and help the Post continue to operate at a high level for your benefit. If you are interested, the Post 90 Honor and Color Guards are still seeking members. As word is getting out, the demand on the Guard's is increasing. Please talk to the Honor Guard Captain, Carl Saitta if you want to join.

February was the beginning of Officer Call for the Legion, the Sons of the American Legion (SAL) and Legion Riders, and there will be some turnover in Command. If you are interested in serving the Legion Post and its 1,000 members as an Officer or Executive Board Committeeman, please put your name on the sign-up sheet posted on the bulletin board by the west entry door. The officer call lasts three months (February, March and April) with the election in May. The term of service is one year from July 2022 to June 2023. Everyone will have a job, so your time will not be wasted. Please serve your Post members and keep the Post running smoothly and with great accountability.

There are several things scheduled in March and April at Post 90. The St. Patrick's Day party is March 17, and the kitchen is serving corned beef and cabbage. Please sign up for a lunch or dinner meal. There will be a raffle that night for a 4-burner grill and a cooler full of goodies. The first ticket drawn gets a choice of the grill or cooler.

As you may or may not know, the kitchen is closed on Sunday and Monday now that the NFL season is over. However, the Canteen typically has food from Noon to 7 PM on the days the kitchen is closed. Usually, it will be one delicious dish for a reasonable price. Please watch for special events throughout the year which may occur on Saturdays and Sundays.

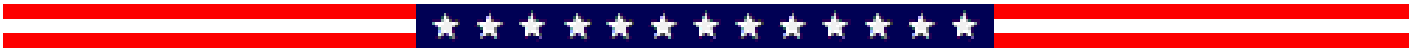

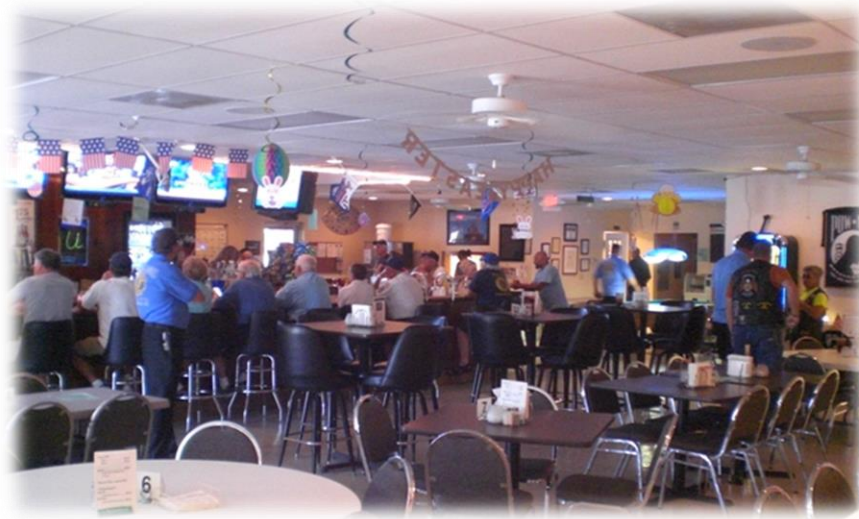
