Hello everyone,

The season is over and Post 90's patronage is slowing down. Our kitchen will be open on Saturdays throughout the summer. We will be celebrating a number of National and military holidays this summer including the Blood Drive on May 7th, Memorial Day, D-Day on June 6th, Flag Day on June 14th, Independence Day, Officer Installation, and others. Also, the Legion Auxiliary is very active and has many events planned. The Legion and Auxiliary are working together to distribute Poppies in May, and we need volunteers. We are still working to have special Saturday dinners. We recognize it is important to provide activities for our members who reside locally and we will try to make it interesting for everyone.

It is election time for American Legion Post 90's Officers, the Executive Committee Members, the Officers of the Sons of the American Legion, Legion Auxiliary, and Legion Riders. There is a great ballot of excellent Legion, SAL, Auxiliary and Rider candidates awaiting your vote. The Legion election is on May 11, 2022 with the SAL, Auxiliary and Rider elections held on other dates. Please take some time to come into the Post and cast your ballot. The installation of all officers (Legion, SAL, Auxiliary and Riders) will be at a date in July that is still to be determined, but is after the Florida Legion Convention.

Memorial Day is celebrated on Monday, May 30th this year. There will be an Everlasting Ceremony held at the Post for the Post 90 members who passed away in the last twelve months. As of this writing, 19 Post 90 members have gone to a higher calling. After the Everlasting Ceremony, free lunch will be served. I will be grilling hamburgers and hot dogs. Please bring a side dish to share with the attendees.



Our participation in manning the First Base Grill at Jet Blue Park for the Boston Red Sox training camp was a success. We raised just under \$20,000 this year to donate to needy charities that aid veterans and the local community. This year 50% of the net proceeds from your hard work will be donated to: Fisher House, Doug Jacobson VA Facility, Vets Helping Vets, Cape Coral Caring Center, and Cape Coral for the Children. However, the charities are reviewed every year and they could change. The remaining 50% will be used to help the Post operate at a higher level for your benefit. Please give a hand to the volunteers who made this a great success! We will be running the First Base Grill at next year's training camp and look forward to seeing old and new volunteers then. Notices will be forthcoming in January 2023.

There is a need to purchase and maintain items within the Post Facility. Our plan is to replace all of the bar stools, renovate the restrooms, and replace the floor tile in the Canteen. With your suggestions, I think the list will grow longer. A plan will be developed to accept donations and give recognition to the donors. More news on this plan will be forthcoming.

Post 90's Honor Guard still needs volunteers. Mostly, the Honor Guard participates in Everlasting Ceremonies for our Post 90 comrades who have passed, but it does participate in private and community events honoring veterans. If you want to participate, Post 90 will purchase your uniform, except for shoes and pants. There is some training involved to get the Honor Guard members refamiliarized with the M-1 Grand, Manual of Arms, and some marching maneuvers. I, personally, would like to see the Post 90 Honor Guard be one of the best in Florida. Please join and give me a call.

If as an American Legion Member, you might qualify to also be a member of the Sons of the American Legion or the Legion Auxiliary, please give some thought to joining. There is a substantial discount on the annual dues for being a Dual Member of the Legion and SAL. If you are a motorcycle enthusiast, don't forget to join the Post 90 Riders organization.

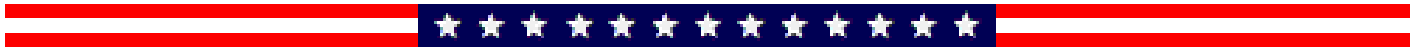

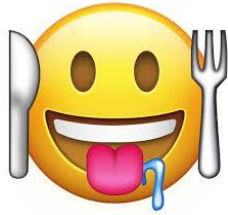

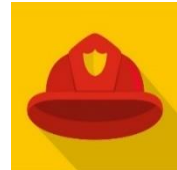
