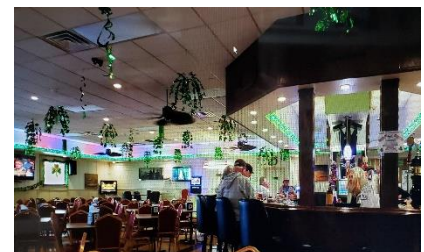

We discussed multiple topics to include the mental health department, the HUD-VASH program and various improvements being made in the health care system. I believe that there will be some positive changes to look forward to. I was also told that the VA will be hiring a few more employees which should help with the wait times.

“Veterans who fought against Iraq in the Gulf War and now battle debilitating symptoms of what’s been called Gulf War Syndrome have widespread inflammation in the brain, researchers at Massachusetts General Hospital confirmed for the first time.”

I know that when I see things like this, I want to know the sample base for the conclusion. The article included this, “[The study](#) included 23 veterans, 15 of whom had Gulf War Illness, as it is identified in the study, as well as 25 healthy patients without GWI. All of their brains were scanned using positron-emission tomography imaging which looked for elevated levels of a special protein that accumulates in the brain and spinal cord when there is inflammation.”

This issue affects my generation and younger military service members and veterans. I would encourage those that have served in the Middle East since 1991 that you get tested and make sure that you do not have these symptoms discussed in the article which can include, “...functions such as memory, concentration and reasoning ...”

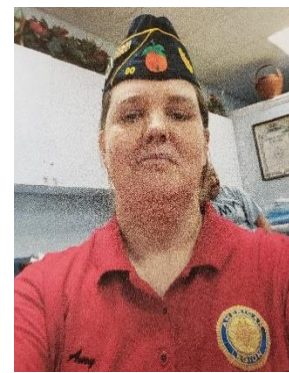


Hello everyone,

American Legion Post 90 in Cape Coral, Florida hosted the annual High School Oratorical Scholarship Contest on Sunday, January 19, 2020. The program is essentially a “Constitutional Speech Contest”. The objective is to instill a better knowledge and appreciation of the Constitution of the United States in high school students. Also, it helps develop leadership qualities, the ability to think and speak as well as an understanding of the rights and responsibilities of American citizenship. The contest consists of two parts - a prepared oration on some aspect of the Constitution with emphasis on duties and responsibilities of a citizen. The second part was an Assigned Topic discussion that the contestants had 5 minutes to prepare. The first place winner, Amanda Benitez, a senior at Cape Coral High School, received a score of 92 from the four judges and received valuable feedback regarding content and speaking skills.

On January 26th, post 90 again hosted the Oratorical Contest but at the District level. The winner again was Amanda Benitez who this time received a score of 91.3 from the three judges. This made Amanda eligible for the competition at the Area level.

On Sunday, February 16th, Amanda Benitez, the winner of both the American Legion Post and District High School Oratorical contest, competed at the Area Contest at Post 110 in Port Charlotte. Despite several interruptions and distractions, Amanda was successful in winning second place and receiving a third scholarship from the Area contest in addition to the awards at the Post and District levels. Amanda is the first student in 5 years, from Post 90, to reach the Area competitive level. Ted Clark, the Chair of our Post's Oratorical Contest, was delighted with Amanda's success and looks forward to next year's competition with a higher number of students. Congratulations to Amanda for her civic knowledge and oratorical skills.

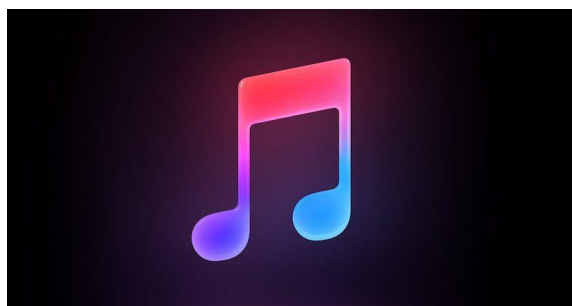

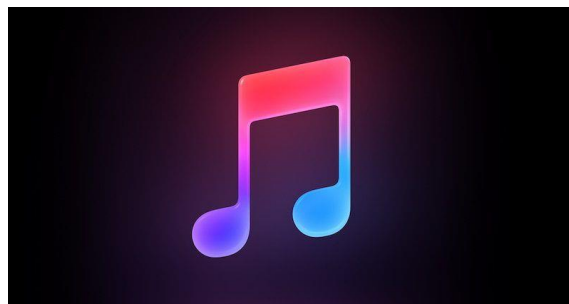
