Hello everyone,

Another year has passed and we are thankful that we survived the year in good financial stead because of your support of Post 90. Post 90 donated a lot of money, blood and sweat to support veterans' charities and to help the needy of Cape Coral. Thanks to the Officers, Executive Board members and you, the members of Post 90.

On January 12, 2018, Post 90 along with Lee Health is hosting a Blood Drive from 1:00 to 5:00 PM. We collected 23 units of blood in October 2018 and would like to exceed that amount in January. Please sign up and support this endeavor. It helps your Lee County and Cape Coral communities.

We are on track to run the First Base Grill at the Boston Rex Sox training camp again this year. The schedule and sign-up sheets are on the bulletin board. There are eighteen events with only one (1) night game. Aramark has asked us if Post 90 can support working in a second stand (#5) this year. We told them yes if we can get enough volunteers to do it otherwise, we will only operate Stand #3, the First Base Grill. Last year we worked Stand #5 four times and the result was we raised nearly \$23,000 for Post 90 and its charities. Bob Buchholz and I feel confident that we can raise \$20,000 this year without Stand #5, but should exceed \$23,000 with Stand #5. Remember that 75% of what we raise goes to veterans and local charities. Please help us support this endeavor.

On February 3, 2019 (Super Bowl Sunday) from 1:00 to 2:00 PM, a Four Chaplains Ceremony will be held at the Post 90. We honor the sacrifice of four Army Chaplains who at 12:55 AM on February 3, 1943 lost their lives when the USAT Dorchester was sunk by a German submarine in the North Atlantic Ocean. On that night 672 men perished and 230 survived. Please join us in celebration of these brave American servicemen.
